Mbarara City Congratulates H.E. Gen. Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, President of the Republic of Uganda, the National Resistance Movement, the Cabinet and all Ugandans on the celebration of the 35th NRM Liberation Day Anniversary.

Government through grants has made it possible for Mbarara Municipality to grow into a City in the last 5 years a status which was achieved on 1st July 2020. Mbarara City now is made up of 2 Divisions (Mbarara City North and Mbarara City South) which are subdivided into 23 Wards (Parishes) which are also made up of 187 Zones (villages). Mbarara is aiming at being an "Inclusive and Self-sustainable" city as its Vision and through different sectors and departments. However, the following shows a summary of some of the achievements of Mbarara City in the last five years;

To facilitate Commerce and Trade, Mbarara Central Market under The Markets and Agricultural Trade Improvement Project (MATIP) funding is in in its final stages of construction.

The achievements under the health sector are divided into infrastructure related developments, curative services and prevention and awareness. Infrastructural developments include; a well-equipped theatre at health centre IV. Upgrae of Kicwamba HCII to HCIII in this Financial Year 2020/2021.

Upgrade of Kyarwabuganda Health centre II to health centre III by constructing an outpatient department, Maternity ward, Jaboratory, pla-

centa lined pit latrines and incinerator. There is no health centre which has faced a shortage (stock out) of essential medicines.

The city Education Sector whose enrolment stands at 30,000 pupils distributed in a 48:52 ratio of Males to Females is manned by 768 Teachers who reside in 166 teacher's houses and operate in 431 classrooms which are equipped with 8561 desks.

Apart from intensified inspection of schools to achieve value for money on all projects, inspection geared towards improvement of academic standards in public schools has been a focus.

has also done a very great job by constructing standard roads with street lights, Bridges, Drainage channels, Beautification projects with walk ways and so many others.

Rehabilitation of Akiki Nyabongo, Macklister, Constantino Lobo and Buremba road (3, 43km) under USMID. Construction of Bishop wills, Bucunku, Mbaguta, Bananuka drive and makhansingh (2.049km) under USMID among so many other roads.

704 solar lights have been installed in different areas of Biharwe, Koranorya, Masaka Road (from mile 2 - Coca cola Round about), Banvu Road, Katete Trading Centre, Kabale Road, Ruti Trading Centre and Fort Portal Road
