Call for Applications to undertake the Post Call Bar Course, 2022/2023 Academic Year

The Academic Registrar Law Development Centre invites applications for admission to the Post Call Bar Course, 2022/2023 Academic Year. The Post Call Bar Course shall be conducted at the Kampala campus. The course shall run from **18th July 2022 to 10th February 2023** as follows:

•	18th July to 28th October 2022	1st Term (Induction, teaching & exams)	(15 weeks)
•	31st October to 4th November 2022	Recess/holiday	(1 week)
•	7th Nov 2022 to 10th Feb 2023	2nd Term (Clerkship)	(12 weeks)

Eligibility

To be eligible for admission to the Post Call Bar Course, the applicant should be:

- a) A Ugandan citizen or a person who normally resides in Uganda; and
- b) A holder of a degree in law obtained from a university or other institution recognised by the Law Council in any of the following countries; and
 - i. All member States of the Commonwealth which operate a common law system.
 - ii. The United States of America (USA other than the State of Louisiana).
 - iii. Canada other than Quebec; and
 - iv. The United Kingdom including Scotland but excluding Guernsey and Jersey.
- c) Either;
 - i. A holder of a qualification that qualifies him or her to enrol in any of the countries listed in (b) above (e.g. Bar Course graduate in a country listed); or
 - ii. A person who has practiced as a legal practitioner in a country listed in (b) above for a period not exceeding one year.

An applicant for the Post Call Bar Course must provide written clearance from the Law Council/CLET to verify his or her eligibility to undertake the Post Call Bar Course. An applicant should write to the Secretary Law Council to secure the said written clearance.

An application shall be subject to any specific or general directions as may be given from time to time by Law Council/CLET.

How to apply

1. Interested applicants may apply online via the link: <https://admissions ldc.ac.ug/>. The link will prompt you to fill in the required information and make payment online before submission of the application.
2. Applicants may download the application form via LDC website (www ldc.ac.ug) and submit the filled form in hard copy at the LDC reception.
3. Applicants may pick an application form from the LDC reception, fill and return it.

The application fee is **UGX 200,000=** excluding bank charges.

Note

The National Council for Higher Education (NHCE) has approved the LDC academic programmes for open, distance and e-learning. The Post Call Bar Course is intended to be conducted physically but where circumstances so require may be conducted online or with a blend of both online and physical learning in accordance with the guidelines issued by the NCHCE and Rules Governing the Post Call Bar Course. **ONLY APPLICANTS WILLING AND ABLE TO UNDERTAKE ONLINE/DISTANCE LEARNING SHOULD APPLY FOR ADMISSION.**

Applications should be submitted not later than **Friday 17th June, 2022.**
